

**FRUITPORT CHARTER TOWNSHIP**

**ORDINANCE NO. 799**

**MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE ORDINANCE**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE FRUITPORT CHARTER TOWNSHIP CODE OF ORDINANCES, SPECIFICALLY BY ADDING ARTICLE V TO CHAPTER 30 TO ADOPT THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE.

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF FRUITPORT, COUNTY OF MUSKEGON, STATE OF MICHIGAN, ORDAINS:

Section 1. Article V of Chapter 30. Article V is added to Chapter 30 of the Fruitport Charter Township Code of Ordinances to state in its entirety as follows.

**ARTICLE V. MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE**

**Sec. 30-101. Michigan vehicle code adopted.**

The Michigan vehicle code, Public Act No. 300 of 1949 (MCL 257.1 et seq.), is adopted by reference.

**Section 30-102. References.**

References in the Michigan vehicle code to "local authority" shall mean the township.

**Section 30-103. Penalties.**

The penalties provided by the Michigan vehicle code are adopted by reference; provided, however, that the township may not enforce any provision of the Michigan vehicle code for which the maximum period of imprisonment is greater than 93 days.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance was approved and adopted by the Township Board on \_\_\_\_\_, 2017, after introduction and first reading on February 13, 2017, and publication after the first reading as required by Michigan Act 359 of 1947, as amended. This Ordinance shall be effective 30 days after publication following adoption.
